

TYLER STREET PROJECT UPDATE

April 30, 2025

Greetings Uptown Property and/or Business Owners,

Thank you for your patience and support as we make much-needed repairs to pedestrian and vehicle access along Tyler Street. The project is moving at a faster pace than originally anticipated and will be completed by the end of May.

The City will close Tyler Street between Lawrence and Jefferson Street to all vehicular traffic **starting Monday, May 5 until Friday, May 9** in order to prepare the road surface and pave the road. The closure is necessary to prepare the street for paving and allowing curing time for cement treatments and asphalt paving. Pedestrians will still be able to access businesses along the corridor and the closure will not impact the Saturday Farmers Market. The sidewalks, bulbouts, and new ramps have been completed for the project. Paving the road surface is the last major phase for this project, with striping of the parking stalls and lanes occurring approximately two weeks after paving.

Project Timeline

Work will occur between 7:00am and 6:00pm, dates are subject to change.

- Week of 4/27: Intermittent closures with flaggers to grind out existing pavement.
- Monday 5/5: Apply a cement treated base to the road bed.
- Tuesday 5/6: Cement treatment will cure.
- Wednesday 5/7: Pave Tyler Street (Lawrence to Jefferson).
- Thursday 5/8: Pave the side streets spurs at each intersection.
- Friday 5/9: Re-open the street.
- End of May: Add road markings, including striping the bike lanes and parking stalls.



Stay Connected

We understand that construction impacts businesses and residents, and we will mitigate the impact of the road closure to accessing businesses and driveways as much as possible. **Property owners and residents should call (253) 307-2301 to inquire about their driveway closures**, which will reach the City's contractor who is directing traffic in and out of the project area during paving.
